

This could include, but is not limited to, information about; or to prevent institutional structures or cultural conditions that facilitate violence, including Bystander intervention includes recognizing situations of potential harm, overcoming barriers to intervening, identifying safe and effective intervention options, and taking action, such as reporting incidents to appropriate authorities. to intervene.

So, to bring social change for reconstructing a society we have to give more attention to improve the health status of the people especially women & Children who are the great sufferers and most neglected section of our society. We believe that not a single effort would be successful in society without considering community health issue. We are sure that Improvement in the health status of women of rural pockets will not only promote them to participate in the development activities for their social upliftment. But also uplift their standard of living and saving lots of money which are being spent on their health treatment.

Keeping these facts in minds and realizing the cause of acute health problems among children and women like unhygienic living. Lack of awareness about- immunization, prevention against diseases, consumption unsafe drinking water, proper intake and nutrition, Acceptance of untrained local Dais during pregnancy, High frequency of birth rate etc. we intervened community health program to reduce the health problem of the rural folks residing in the slums in Delhi.

Culture can be defined as "the arts and other manifestations of human intellectual achievement regarded collectively." As a dynamic phenomenon, cultures are under constant change and they must adapt to environmental changes. This is one of the universal features of a culture. After globalization, the world became more interconnected and today most societies consist of ethnically diverse populations. This has given rise to conflicts associated with ethnicity, religion, and ethical beliefs which are all central concepts in cultures. More than ever before, culture is no longer fixed but rather in constant motion. At a time when cultures adapt and become more fluid, a need has been identified to protect and preserve the past. There are organizations such as the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) whose objectives include conserving and protecting cultural and natural heritage along with the promotion of international

cooperation, peace, and security.

Because culture affects how people behave and interact with each other, it helps you build relationships with others when you understand other cultures and perspectives. It's also good to understand how much in common we have with other people even if at first glance their cultures might seem completely different. We are all humans and have similar needs, hopes, fears, and things that make us happy...

A Free medical Camp can be considered as a life-saving program that aims to provide free medical and surgical services to poor communities living in rural or urban areas by a mobile team with varieties of medical specialized services. So, medical camps provide free medical advice, medicine to the unfortunate people and refer for specialized treatment or surgery whenever it is required. These camps make sure people are getting healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.

Sanitization is a process of cleaning certain area or surface in such a manner so that it is made bacteria-free and elementally clean all types of microbes and viruses that can infect the human body and cause different kinds of diseases.

Hand Sanitization is a process of cleaning the human body especially hands that can get infected with any contagious microbes

when the hands touch any infected surfaces, animals, or humans.

Surface Sanitization is a process of removing or destroying microorganisms from places like clothing, vegetables, water, and all kinds of hard surfaces. Sanitization is a pragmatic approach to tackle the issues associated with infection and contamination.

Over the years society has undergone many changes among which fragmentation of land holdings has substantially affected the income generating capacities of small & marginal farmers. Changing moral values and lack of employment opportunities for the youth have affected the attitude of the youth towards the older generation within the family and society at large.

Traditional norms of respect and care for old are now difficult to see, affecting the social condition of old persons in the society. In almost every village, quite a few old persons can be seen having great difficulty even in getting two square meals, where food is provided the neglect and disrespect has broken them even more bitterly.

SATYASHODHAK BUDDHIST FOUNDATION has initiated Old Aged welfare programme with the support of donors. During the reporting period the NGO distributed clothes, blankets, nutrition and grain to old aged persons. They are provided medicines and given proper treatment in hospitals escorted by our volunteers.

Welfare is one of the priority areas for the SATYASHODHAK old Age Welfare is one of the priority areas for the SATYASHODHAK BUDDHIST FOUNDATION. The Organisation strongly believes that the elderly poor are entitled to the essentials of life and that we the elderly provide them. The Organisation granted food, clothes and should provide them assistance in getting pension from the blankets and other assistance in getting pension from the government department.

SATYASHODHAK BUDDHIST FOUNDATION has given the special attention on old age persons during the health checkup camps. They are provided treatment for the old age diseases and served free medicines. The Organisation also provided financial assistance to the poor destitute old aged person

ribal Welfare performs the statutory and administrative functions relating to protection and empowerment of scheduled tribes in the state. It is also responsible for preparing the Tribal Sub Plan and monitoring of implementation. Implementation and monitoring of Welfare schemes is carried in various ways
